High quality projects which are able to benefit a large amount of people with a little amount of money will likely have the best chances.

# WHAT KIND OF EVENTS WILL BE SUPPORTED AND WHAT KIND OF EQUIPMENT CAN BE REQUESTED?

We very much encourage the membership to be creative. Examples of past grants include funding events such as our highly successful Cellobrations and Viola Days, as well as funding for guest artists visiting schools. Other possible requests may come to support existing programs in terms of equipment and repair.
